### New Data Protection Policy

### New Terms and Conditions

Saville Assessment is reviewing processes to ensure we meet the new requirements being laid out by the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) coming into effect across Europe on May 25<sup>th</sup> 2018.

As part of this, we have undergone a review of our policies and will be asking all Oasys users (candidate and administrator) to acknowledge they have read a revised Data Protection Policy and Terms & Conditions.

### Integration Clients

For clients with integrations, there will be an additional step created in the workflow. When the candidate clicks on the go-link on the first page they will see the Privacy Policy page. ## Transport Layer Security

Transport Layer Security (TLS) is the most widely deployed security protocol used for Web browsers and other applications that require data to be securely exchanged over a network.

### How does this affect you?

Oasys is a web-based service; you engage with it through a secured network connection. Those connections are secured by TLS.

As new browsers and operating systems are released, new security standards are added. However, older versions of a browser or operating system are not updated to include the newer standards.

Updating your operating system and browser versions means secure sites, such as Oasys, can safely allow you to connect to them. We recommend updating your browser regularly to ensure that you have the latest security patches and support for the latest and most secure protocols.

We will provide more technical information on this closer to the June 30<sup>th</sup> deadline. However if you require details of minimum browser requirements prior to then, please get in touch.

## Select Language Functionality on Oasys

Within a platform, administrators can configure a setting that allows assesses to select the language they would like to complete their assessments in before the assessment starts. By default, this is currently turned OFF.

However, following feedback from several clients, we are going to be changing the default to be turned ON for all platforms. Administrators can still turn this off on a 'per project' basis.
