

Saville Assessment Wave® Focus Styles Senior Managers & Executives (UK, IA, 2021) Group Description

This group consisted of 2,464 individuals¹ in the United Kingdom, employed in a range of job functions across a wide range of industry sectors. 13% worked in IT & engineering, 13% in operations, 11% in finance, 7% in health, 6% in sales & marketing, 6% in consulting, 5% in human resources, 3% in transport, 2% in purchasing and 2% in construction. The remaining 32% worked in other fields including law, customer service, education, administration and hospitality².

The breakdown of the group is provided below (with group response rates for each biographical section given in the footnotes):

Gender³

33% of the group were female, 67% were male and less than 1% responded with not specified.

Age⁴

The mean age of the group was 44 years.

Education (highest qualification)⁵

29% had a postgraduate degree as their highest qualification, 37% had a first/undergraduate degree, 21% had a professional qualification, 8% had school level qualifications, with the remaining 5% of the group having other or no formal qualifications.

Management Level⁶

63% of the group were senior managers, 16% were functional managers, 11% were business managers, 6% were group managers and 4% were enterprise/corporate managers.

Work Experience⁷

65% of the group had more than 20 years' work experience, 29% had between 10 and 20 years', 4% had between 6 and 9 years' and 1% had between 3 and 5 years' work experience.

Cultural Background8

90% of the group described themselves as White (including British, European and Irish), 5% as Asian (including Indian, Pakistani and Bangladeshi), 2% as Black (including African, Caribbean and African and Caribbean), with the remaining 3% coming from a range of other backgrounds⁹.
